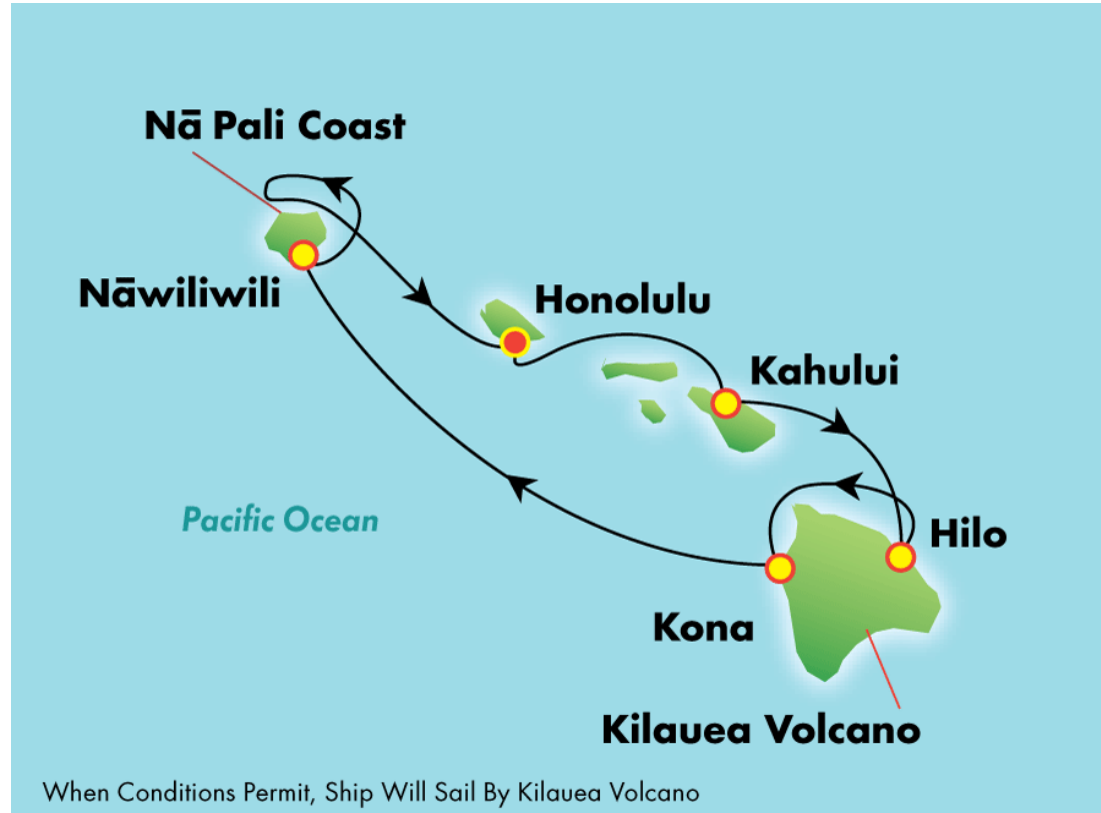

Your small group guided tour of the Polynesian Cultural Center will include admission to the villages and exhibits in **Hawai'i, Tahiti, Tonga, Samoa, Aotearoa (New Zealand), Fiji, and Hawaiian Mission Settlement.**

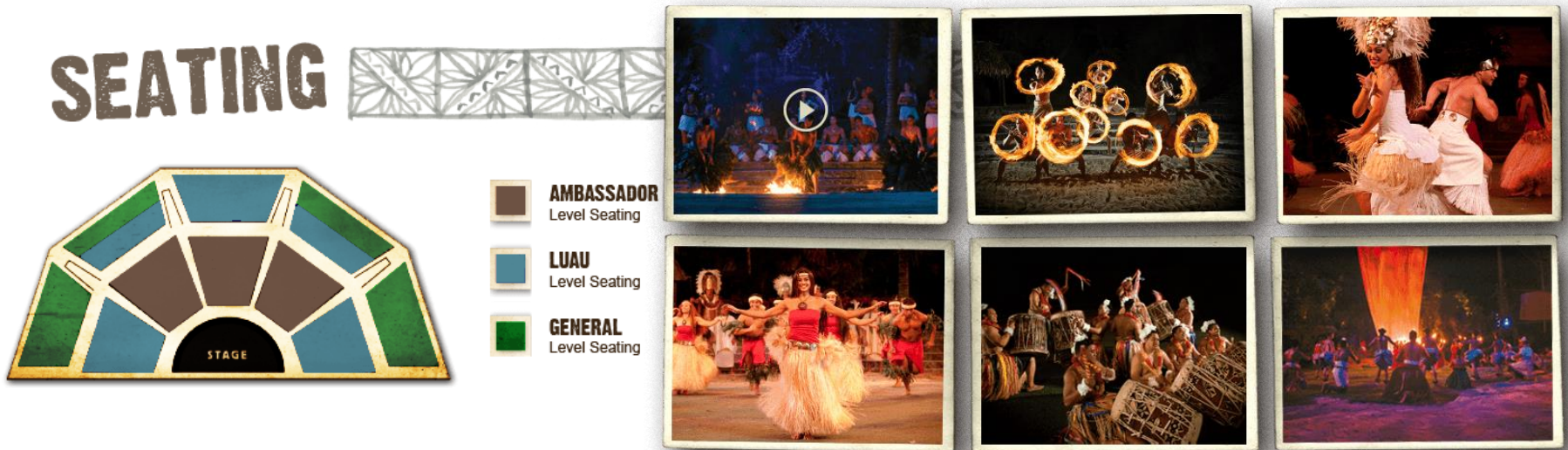

Following the luau and a little free time for shopping and a restroom break, you will make your way to the main theater where you will be seated in the Ambassador Level Seating Area (center 3 sections in front of the stage) for the "Ha: Breath of Life" show from 7:30 to 8:45 pm. After the show, your bus will return you to the Waikiki Resort Hotel where you should arrive by around 10:00 pm filled with memories of your whirlwind tour of the Pacific Islands all in one location at the Polynesian Cultural Center.



# Tour 2 – Maui – Whale Watching

Sunday, February 4 – 10:30 am to 2:30 pm - (4 hours)

\$100 per person



Our 56-passenger exclusive motorcoach will meet us at the pier in Kahului and transport us to Ma'ālaea Harbor where we will board our large double decked stabilized yacht (certified for 149 passengers) for a two hour trip to observe the amazing Pacific Humpback Whales up close and personal. We will see the wonderful, migratory Pacific Humpbacks as they enjoy the warm waters of the Hawaiian Islands to breed and birth their calves.

# Tour 2 – Maui – Whale Watching

The waters off of Maui are well known as one of the best places in all of Hawaii to see these incredible, majestic whales and offer spectacular sightseeing and photo opportunities. Expert whale narration will be provided by our experienced and professional Captain and Crew, and an underwater hydrophone will also be available for our listening pleasure (subject to water conditions and whale proximity). Our big, comfortable boat will get us quickly to each whale sighting, with an enclosed main cabin and upper observation deck to ensure dry, 360 degree views. We are guaranteed to see whales on this trip or you can go again the next day for free.





# Tour 2 – Maui – Whale Watching

Unlimited filtered water will be provided at no extra charge, and you can also purchase soda, juice, beer, wine, and tropical well drinks during our tour. In addition, snacks will be available for purchase on the boat or you may bring aboard your own food/snacks if you prefer. However please note that the vessel is CASHLESS for purchases. Only credit, debit or digital payment methods with a QR code will be accepted for on board purchases. Cash will graciously be accepted for gratuities only. If our past whale watching adventures in Hawaii are any indication, you won't want to miss this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.

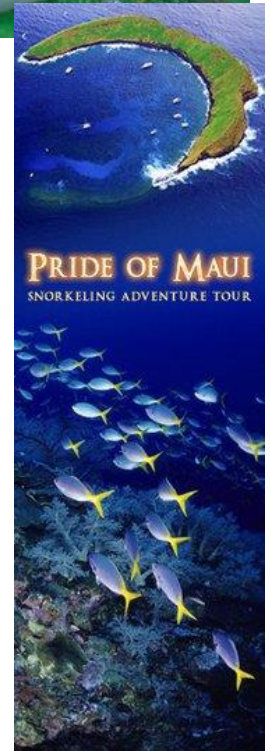
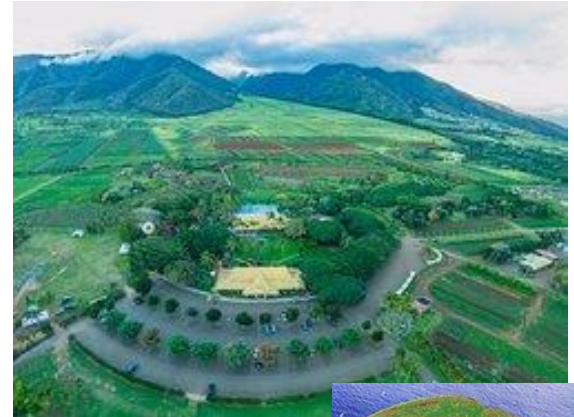

# Maui on Your Own for Monday, February 5

- There should be plenty of reasonably priced **taxis/Ubbers** or other **private tour options** available at the Kahului Harbor pier in Maui – especially if you simply wish to spend the day at a nearby beach
- In fact, **Kite Beach Maui** - where the kite surfers hang out, and **Kanaha Beach Park** are only about a mile or two from the pier
- Another option is to **rent a car** from the nearby Kahului Airport (most major car rental agencies are located at the airport) to which you can take an Uber to the airport in the morning and back to the ship at the end of the day. In fact, your hosts have rented a mini van (\$116) and plan to tour the **Road to Hana** on Monday, February 5 using the Shaka App on our cell phone for the “Classic Road to Hana Tour” (\$19.99) – but other Shaka tours are also available on Maui

Everyone who I have ever talked to who has taken this tour tells me that it was the highlight of their trip to Hawaii. So we just have to see for ourselves why this tour is so popular. Our mini vans will take each group over to Kauai Backcountry Adventures, which is only 10 minutes from the pier, where we will check in for our 3-hour Mountain Tubing Adventure on which we will witness Kauai's spectacular, historic engineering feats as we float down the open canals and through five amazing tunnels and flumes engineered and hand-dug circa 1870!



# Tour 4 – Kauai - Mountain Tubing Adventure

The gently flowing waters, beautiful scenery, flumes, and tunnels create a relaxing, fun, and fascinating experience. And when they say they are unique, they mean it! This is the only tubing activity of this type on Kaua'i, and they are the only eco-tour company with access to these 17,000 acres of former plantation lands. After we are checked in, we will hop in one of their four-wheel drive vehicles and traverse the former Lihue Plantation lands as we ride deep into Kauai's pristine emerald green interior, where our exclusive tubing adventure begins! Start off by enjoying breathtaking vistas of Mt. Wai'ale'ale, deemed one of the wettest spots in the world and the second highest point on the island of Kaua'i. Witness her spectacular waterfalls before arriving at our launch site, where you will grab a tube, don a headlamp, and jump in the gently flowing waters





# Tour 4 – Kauai - Mountain Tubing Adventure

Enjoy the wonder and magic of each tunnel illuminated by your headlamp. At the end of your adventure, you are guided to an enchanted picnic area for a delicious lunch and a cool dip in a natural swimming hole. There's no better way to experience the Kaua'i mountains! It is suggested that we bring: secured water friendly shoes, NO FLIP FLOPS (rental shoes available); swimsuit or clothing that can get wet; towel (from the ship) and a dry change of clothing; REEF SAFE sunscreen; hat (recommended but not required); and bug repellent (Kelly will provide). They will provide: helmets, headlamps & gloves, tubes, delicious lunch and water (two hours into the tour), and hand sanitizer. Maximum Weight - 300 pounds (we will be weighed at check in). This activity is not recommended for those with back, hip, or knee problems.

- Another option is to **rent a vehicle** from the nearby Lihue International Airport (most major car rental agencies are located at the airport) to which you can take an Uber back and forth from the airport, and perhaps park overnight at the airport too if you rent for 2 days. Your hosts have rented mini vans for both days (\$226) which we will use to transport our group to and from our excursions each day (with volunteer drivers). The Shaka App also has suggested driving tours on Kauai including: North Shore Kauai Driving Tour; Waimea and Na Pali Driving Tour; Wailua Valley and Waterfalls Tour; and Poipu and Koloa Driving Tour.



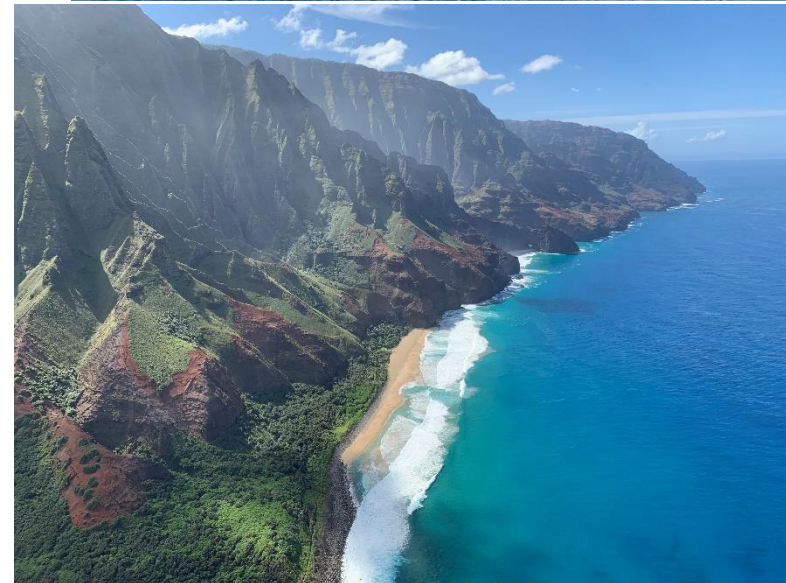
# Tour 5 – Kauai

## Na Pali Coast Sailing & Snorkeling

Friday, February 9 – 6:30 am to 1:30 pm - (7 hours)

A trip to Kauai just wouldn't be complete without seeing the spectacular Na Pali Coast up close and personal. So we have arranged this morning sailing trip and snorkeling tour (snorkeling is optional) for the final day of our cruise. In the morning, our mini vans will drive us to Port Allen (about a 30 minute drive) where we will check in at Blue Dolphin Charters. Trust me, the highlight of your vacation will be this Kauai Na Pali Coast Sailing Tour adventure aboard a spacious 65-foot catamaran with fresh water showers and clean bathrooms for both men and women. The 3 to 4,000 foot high cliffs of the world famous Na Pali Coast are truly one of nature's most brilliant masterpieces and only visible by air or boat.





# Tour 5 – Kauai - Na Pali Coast Sailing & Snorkeling

People who have traveled the world over say that there is no other place that matches the splendor of the Na Pali Coast. These magnificent cliffs and valleys have been used as backdrops by Hollywood in movies like *Jurassic Park*, *6 days 7 nights*, and many others.

Whether you are young or old, non-swimmer or a salty ocean veteran, this tour will provide fun activities and all the gear for every level of participation. In the morning, we will travel far up the Na Pali coast for spectacular sightseeing. Be sure to keep a watch for the leaping Spinner Dolphins (guaranteed dolphin sighting on this tour) and perhaps a whale or two.

During our tour, you will be treated to a continental breakfast and full deli buffet lunch (included in your price). Later, during our return trip, you will get a chance to snorkel among turtle and tropical fish. If you're not into snorkeling, grab an ice cold beverage, a good book and relax on deck or on a nice bench in the shade below deck. Our tour includes: tropical breakfast, deli-style lunch, snorkeling equipment (wetsuit rentals available), water, juice & soft drinks, with beer, wine & Mai Tais served with lunch. It is suggested that we bring: a camera, sunscreen (NO spray sunscreen), towel (from the ship), bathing suit, photo ID (For 21+ access to bar), motion sickness preventatives if necessary (Kelly will bring Motion Eaze), light rain jacket or windbreaker (optional). There's truly something for everyone on this trip. 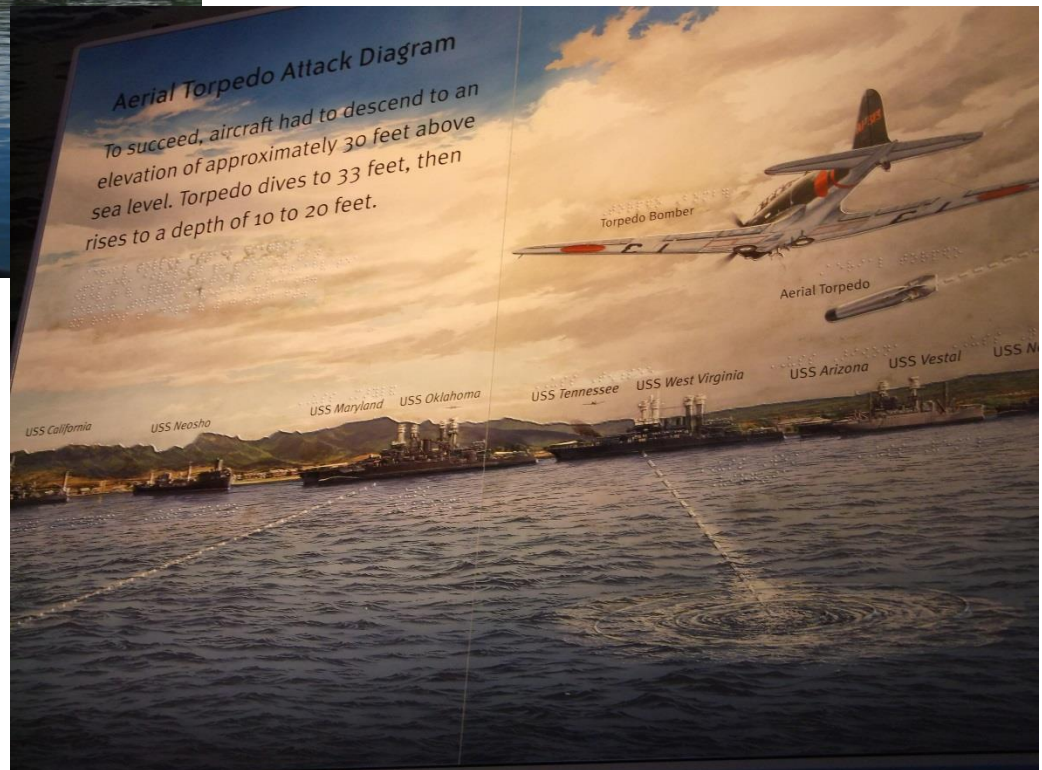

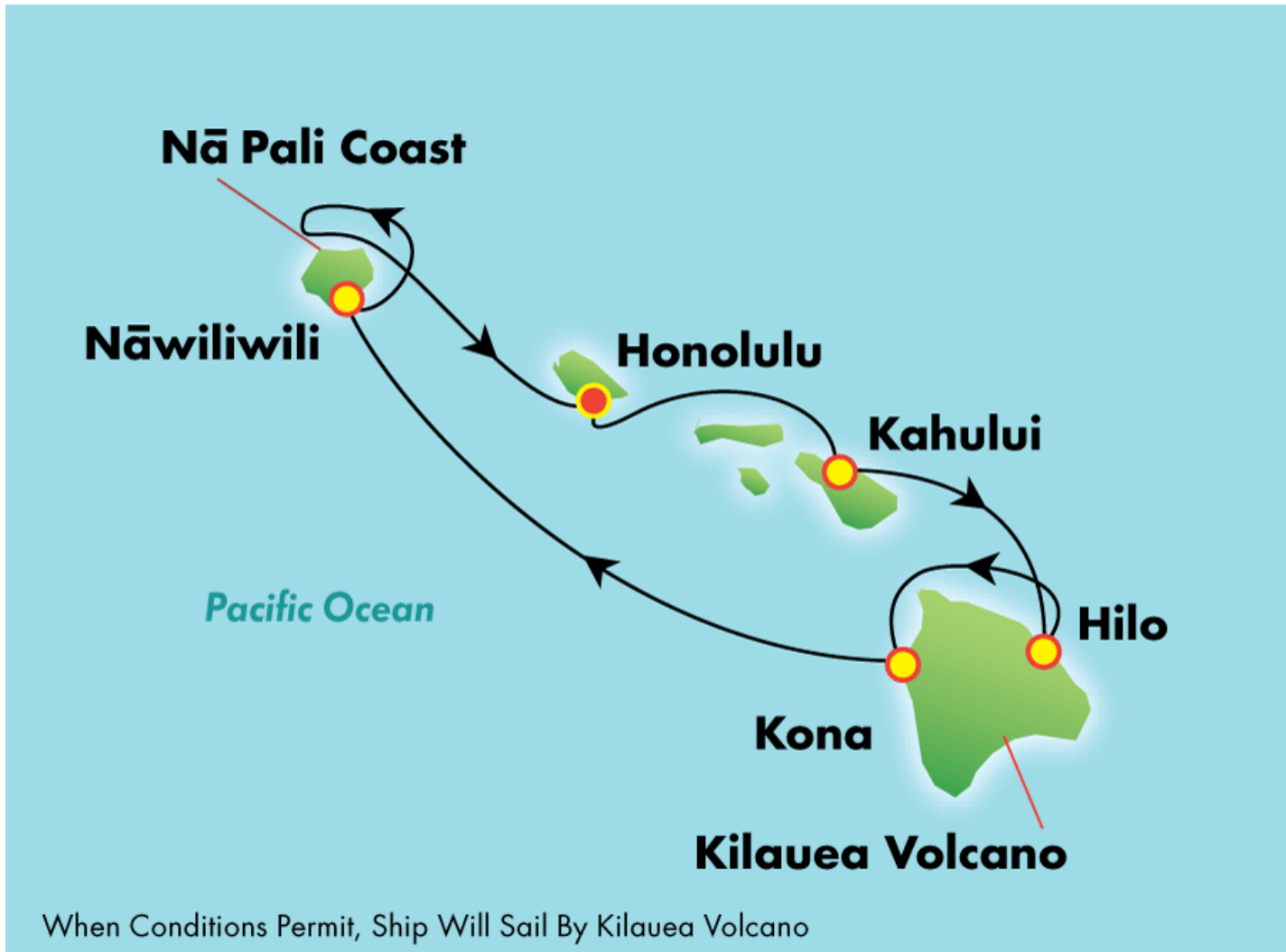

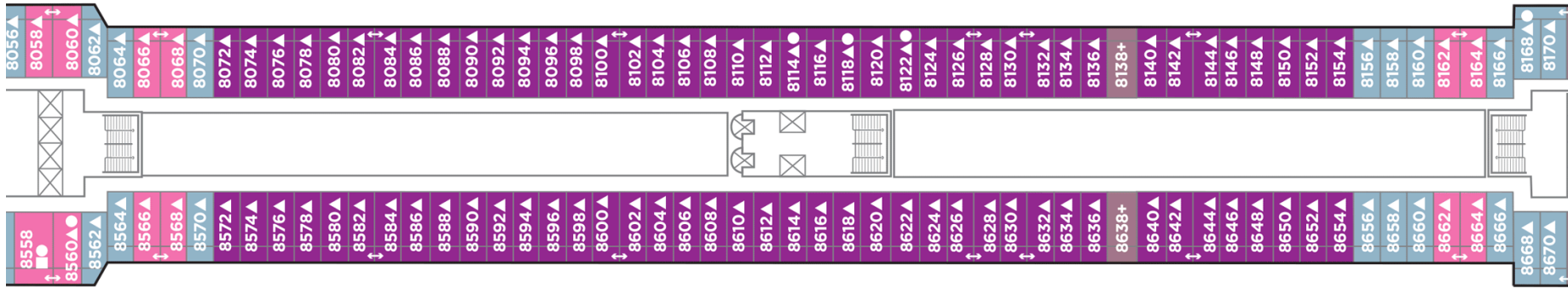

# **Cancellation Penalties and Worldwide Trip Protector Policy**

- **While most of you have purchased the Trip Protector Plan, a few of you have not yet purchased protection. Please be advised of the following cancellation penalties:**
- Cancel on or after today (November 9, 2023), receive a partial refund with remainder covered by the Worldwide Trip Protector or Worldwide Trip Protector Edge Policy for qualifying reasons
  - Amount of refund/cancellation penalties depends upon date of cancellation
  - Cancel by: November 15, 2023 – 50% penalty; by December 15, 2023 – 75% penalty; on or after December 16, 2023 – 100% penalty
- Salisbury Cruise & Travel, LLC encourages the purchase of either a **Worldwide Trip Protector** Policy or a **Worldwide Trip Protector Edge** Policy from Travel Insured International (TII) to cover your cruise for cancellation (due to illness or injury), trip interruption, trip delay, baggage loss or delay, accident/sickness medical protection, emergency evacuation and more. While we are no longer able to offer a Group Policy, we encourage you to purchase your policy through our agency by clicking on the link provided in the pdf version of our registration form.
